

#### Supporting Sustainable Communities

Each year, EMC invests in projects centered on historic rehabilitation and preservation, as well as low income housing, contributing to the strength and sustainability of our communities.

In 2022, EMC invested \$9.2M toward these community improvement efforts.







### Impact Story: Renewable Energy

EMC partnered with students at the Vaughan Institute of Risk Management at University of Iowa's Tippie College of Business to conduct a risk assessment on policyholder concerns regarding sustainability. Students assessed sustainable energy sources, such as geothermal heating and solar panels, and made recommendations that EMC could consider implementing for its policyholders to become more sustainable.



The Corporate Governance & Nominating Committee helps establish appropriate corporate governance policies and practices in areas such as selecting new directors, succession planning for executives and evaluating proposed changes to key governing documents.
